The picture on the right is the cherry blossoms of Sakuragawa Cherry Tree. The trees stand in the Isobe Sakuragawa Park. Also, the ones standing along the path towards Sakuragawa Isobe Inamura Shrine are selected as national scenic beauty. All the cherry trees in the area are designated as Sakuragawa Cherry Tree, a national natural treasure, too.







The town of Makabe stretches in the west side of Makabe Castle Site. a national historic treasure. You can feel the atmosphere of the old time of the Edo period, when watching the historic town structure, warehouses and gates.


The town was designated as an Important Preservating District for Groups of Historic Building in 2010.

Mt. Ontake and Mt. Amabiki feature easy access from Iwase station. Mt. Tsukuba is accessible from Lake Tsukushi and through Yakuoin Temple. Mt. Kaba with huge rocks has been worshiped as a sacred mountain.

Enjoy cycling on Tsukuba= Kasumigaura Ring Ring


This is a long cycling road of a total length 180km. It connects Iwase Station in Sakuragawa and Itako station via the city of Tsuchira and Lake Kasumigaura. On the way of cycling in Sakuragawa, you can enjoy the mountain view of Mt. Amabiki, Mt. Kaba and Mt. Tsukuba as well as the old town street of Makabe.












A trip to encounter a nostalaic landscape



The road from Iwase to Tsuchiura utilizes the disconnected railroad of old Tsukuba Line. While cycling, you can feel the traces of good old days when the railway was in operation. Fukure-Mikan mandarin oranges have been cultivated in the Makabe district since ancient times. Their dried peels with good aroma are used as an ingredient of shichimi-togarashi, a table spice for Japanese dishes.



The Makabe district is the northern limit in mandarin orange cultivation. Tourist farms are open from late October to December. Please enjoy the rich sweet-

Sakuragawa produces Inada granite, Makabe granite, Haguro Aonukame granite and other quality stones.


The stone production is a symbolic industry offering gravestones, stone lanterns and art works. They create a new field of stone products that more people have got involved in lately.


